- Activities might involve making items from wood or metal such as toys, bird boxes and memorial benches, mending or repairing things, such as bikes, furniture woodworking, engineering, renovation, reclamation and gardening. Activities are dependent on the interests of the men involved.
- It's an opportunity to make friends, enjoy good banter, have fun and perhaps eat a bit of cake and drink lots of coffee and tea as well as learning new skills.
